Ash Wednesday: The Lenten Season

This Wednesday 26th February is Ash Wednesday. It marks the beginning of the Lenten Season. A time for reflection

and prayer in the lead up to the Easter Season.

Traditionally there are 3 themes of Lenten observance: prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

Through *prayer* we encounter God in our lives. We pray not only for our needs, but the needs of others.

At school we encourage the children to pray and thank God for the many gifts in creation. We ask God for help to be more like Jesus in the way we speak and act towards others.

At home we encourage the children to pray together with mum and dad at meal times and before going to sleep.

Fasting helps us to turn away from selfishness and toward the light of Christ. We give up something so that others will have more. We fast in order to remind ourselves to change our lives in positive ways.

At school we encourage the children to eat fewer sweets and contribute the money saved to the Project Compassion Box to help others who are hungry. We encourage the children to exchange complaining comments for words of praise to each other.

At home we encourage the children to watch maybe one less television show per week and use this time to help mum or dad around the home.

Almsgiving. The gospels list many examples of Jesus' helping others. As Christians, we too are to give of our time, talents and resources so that others can live better.

At school we encourage the children to show compassion to someone who is sad or hurting. Encouraging children to do extra jobs around the home and donating some of their earned money to the Missions or maybe giving away outgrown clothes or toys to Charity. Encouraging forgiveness rather than keeping a grudge.

Through prayer, fasting and almsgiving the children can put into practice the spirit of the Lenten season.

QKR: Canteen orders can be taken using the **QKR** app. When accessing QKR for the first time in 2020, existing families will be asked to update their details. This will mean choosing the updated class name from those presented. New enrolments should choose the class their child / ren have been enrolled into. Details about QKR is included with this newsletter and from the office.

ATTENTION DRIVERS

Once again, in the interest of keeping our children safe let me make it clear



The school carpark is closed from 8.40am until 9.15am and from 2.30pm until 3.15pm. The school carpark is far too small for us to allow parents to use it to drop off or pick up children. In addition and far more importantly it is an entry point for children and families and moving cars create a safety issue. It is only for the use of staff and services. Parents working on canteen and when picking up sick children are also able to use it, otherwise -

PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN THE CARPARK.

Wet weather is not an excuse to use the carpark. I would rather someone got wet than hit by a car. Accidents happen no matter how careful you are.

The short entrance road to the carpark is not to be used as a drop off point.

The **Bus Zone at** the front of the school on Main Road means you are not allowed to stop your vehicle unless you are driving a bus. So between 8am-9.30am and 2.30pm-4pm on school days it **is not a drop off area.**

Please set a good example to your children.

- Do not park across our neighbours driveways
- Use the crossing in Durham Drive and not cut across the corner
- Do not walk when the signal is red
- Do not call your children across the road

Your child should know how they are getting home each day. Once an afternoon routine is established and teachers get to know how your child usually gets home, alterations should be notified to your child's teacher. This would be a great assistance when your child isn't where they are supposed to be.

Taking a child home, even just into the car park, when you think they need your help, because you are a neighbour or you are a close friend IS NOT A GOOD IDEA!

You are asked to pass on this information to anyone who may not get this message; partner, grandparent, friend, neighbour; specially if they transport your child (ren) to and or from school.



Our school will appear in 'Nearby Locations' if you're within 10kms of the school, or search for our school by name.


Step 4 Register your children
